We are doing a research study to determine whether frequent **home telemetric monitoring** of blood pressure can be used to safely guide medication changes to **intensively lower blood pressure** to reduce damage to the cerebral small blood vessels after spontaneous ICH

The key inclusion criteria are:

- Over the age of 30
- Blood Pressure: ≥ 130 mm Hg
- Taking less than 3 BP lowering medications
- presumed to have cerebral small vessel disease (hypertensive arteriopathy or cerebral amyloid angiopathy, or both)
