# **RECRUITMENT PROGRESS**

- **Total recruitment: 36 participants**
- **Recruitment target: 112 participants**
- End of recruitment date: 31/12/2020
- **Recruitment is suspended until further** notice due to the limitations created by **COVID-19**.

## **FOLLOW UP VISITS**

3 month follow up visit – to be done remotely

- 24 hr ABPM should still happen as • scheduled. Please contact the Oxford team by email for guidance in advance of the visit.
- Please keep a screening log of potentially eligible participants for recruitment later or a list of ICH patients if you have staff capacity issues

### **MRI SCANS**

- Before the 12 month visit, please contact your MRI radiographers to ask if there have been any scanner upgrades and to check that the scan sequences planned are the same as those at baseline.
- Please email <u>m.dabagh@ucl.ac.uk</u> to let us know about the scanner upgrades.

For cognitive assessment, use 22 point telephone MoCA instead.

12 month follow up visit – all parts of the visit are postponed

- The visit should happen as close as possible to the scheduled visit, once restrictions are lifted.
- Please delay eCRF completion • until then.
