




# Sleep and Chronobiology Summer School 20–24 July 2015



The Sleep and Circadian Neuroscience Institute (SCNi) at the University of Oxford is hosting a sleep medicine and chronobiology (primarily circadian clock) summer school.

The five-day school will consist of a series of shared lectures and seminars as well as separate, subject-specific workshops. The aim is to give attendees a practical understanding of their subject area, from fundamental research to applied science. The school is targeted at PhD/DPhil/MD students and early career researchers.

- **30 January 2015:** closing date for applications
- 2 March 2015: decisions announced
- 6 March 2015: online registration opens

- 1. Covering letter, including confirmation that if offered a place you will be able to attend. Please indicate whether you would like to attend the sleep medicine or the chronobiology workshops.
- 2. A research abstract of your current work. This should be no more than one page of A4 in Arial font, size 11 (approx. 300 words), to include one table or figure if applicable. If accepted this will form the basis of your poster presentation at the School.
- 3. A short CV including research interests.
