TRIAL STATUS

Nationally, 13 centres have been asked to participate (UCLH, Oxford, Glasgow, Edinburgh, Cambridge, Manchester, Newcastle, Imperial, Nottingham, King's, St George's, Royal Preston and Sheffield) and have agreed to take part. We anticipate you all will be able to continue to support us to get this exciting trial up and running this year.

The trial protocol underwent a review process through the steering committee members and before the protocol was finalised and was submitted to R&D for provisional sponsorship approval and is currently being reviewed. When provisional sponsorship is granted we will submit to Ethics and HRA approval. Once approval is in place we will be able to carry out the necessary site set-up and contracts will be finalised.

We are aiming to start patient recruitment from April 2018.

We are excited to get this trial up and running this year and we would like to thank you again for your continued help and support!
